

## Duties of the Chamber of Commerce Quilt Display Coordinators

The Chamber of Commerce Co-chairs: (one from TBQ, one from MTQ)

- select a theme of quilts to be displayed
- solicit display quilts to be hung from local quilter offerings
- coordinate with the Chamber of Commerce Information Manager
- hang the display quilts for two to three months, after which they are returned to their owners
- provide news articles to TBQ and MTQ as necessary
- notify guild photographers when the quilts have been changed so that they may be photographed and posted to the guilds' websites
- provide a year-end report of activities, issues, concerns, and suggestions to the Guild Presidents in June

History: Beginning in April 2009, at the suggestion of TBQ member Roni Barron, who volunteers at the Chamber of Commerce Visitor Information Office on the Prescott downtown square, TBQ began displaying a couple of quilts along with the quilt show fliers, to advertise the 2009 TBQ Quilt Show. After the show, Robert Coombs, Visitor Information Manager for the Prescott Chamber of Commerce, expressed disappointment in no longer having quilts hanging. In discussions with Robert, 2009-2010 TBQ President Joanne Storer and Sam Logan, 2009 – 2010 MTQ President, it was agreed to continue this quilt display on an on-going basis. Information is posted beside each quilt, naming TBQ and MTQ as local guild, along with the contact information for each guild.
